No Longer Available

We have to say 'goodbye' to two products from the range, due, I believe, to low world-wide sales: the **Echinacea Supreme** and **Sunless Tanning Lotion**. However, to help you out, I have done some research and found suitable replacement products.



A.Vogel Echinaforce™ Forte

This is an excellent replacement, and from my own experience it is nearly as effective as the Forever product. Be careful, it comes in two strengths; make sure you ask for the 'Forte' as they both have similar packaging.

Palmers Natural Bronze Body Lotion

Again, this is a very acceptable substitute, but without any Aloe Vera in it. A good solution is to mix it 50/50 with the Forever Aloe Lotion. It blends well and gives you both products at once. Do remember, a sunless tanning lotion usually does not have any sun protection factor.

Both these products are available in the high street from Boots and other pharmacies, and apothecary shops.



Microbeads

Microbeads are used in a wide variety of bath and beauty products, commonly being found in soap, toothpaste and scrubs. They come in different shapes and colours, and also offer exfoliation. Microbeads are made from plastic (commonly polyethylene) and are not biodegradable. Eventually, they find their way into streams, rivers and the ocean. Animals in these waters are unable to digest the microbeads. Studies have shown that marine life such as mussels and tiny crustaceans ingest the microbeads which remain in their digestive track or migrate to other body tissue. Likewise, humans who eat the seafood are unable to digest microbeads.

Natural Alternative

Exfoliation is the process of removing dead skin cells and it is key to healthy, soft and glowing skin. Exfoliation can be done physically by using an abrasive material on the skin, or chemically with substances such as glycolic acid. There are lots of scrubby exfoliation options for bath and beauty products with one of

the most popular type of exfoliant being jojoba beads, which are produced from jojoba oil. Jojoba beads are commonly mistaken for plastic microbeads; whilst the two products look and feel very much alike, they are vastly different.

Jojoba Beads

Jojoba oil is a liquid wax derived from the jojoba shrub. The wax is processed to a solid wax, which is referred to as a jojoba ester.

These jojoba esters are jojoba beads. Spherical in shape, jojoba beads are biodegradable and come in a wide variety of colours and shapes. Jojoba beads make a great choice for a wide variety of bath and beauty products because the edges of the beads are smooth. This smooth shape avoids microscopic tears to the surface of the skin. The combination of gentle exfoliation and fun colours make them a great choice for scrubs, soaps and other products.

Other natural products used include fragments of apricot kernels, nut shells, eggshells and fine rock particles. None of these will harm the environment, but their use will cause microscopic damage, tears, to our skin, which can cause redness, soreness or even allow bacteria to infect the skin surface.

Forever Products

I am sure it comes as no surprise to learn that Forever does not use, and never has, plastic microbeads. The Aloe Scrub (above) and other exfoliating products use jojoba beads, whilst the Forever Bright Toothgel, Aloe Hand & Face Soap and Avocado Face & Body Soap all rely on the natural and effective cleansing action of the saponins in aloe.
